NGA's Administration Transition Priorities Include the Importance of SEP and WAP

The National Governors Association (NGA) released a report on the governors' top priorities as the Trump Administration takes office this week. The NGA report - *We the States: Governors' Recommendations for the President-Elect* - outline key areas to produce positive outcomes for Americans.



Governors of Colorado, Utah and Nevada Announce Joint Action to Build Regional Electric Vehicle Corridor

The Governors of Colorado, Utah and Nevada recently announced that they will work together over the year to develop complementary plans for building an electric vehicle charging network across key highway corridors in their states. In total, the charging network will connect more than 2,000 miles of highway.



Iowa Releases New State Energy Plan

The Iowa Energy Office (which is housed within the Iowa Economic Development Authority) and the Iowa Department of Transportation recently released the Iowa Energy Plan, which outlines a 10 year effort, with 15 objectives and 45 strategies outlined in a 100+ page report. Key themes include energy workforce development, alternative fuel vehicles, and electric



grid modernization, among others.

Hawaii Aims to Lead in Energy Efficiency, in Addition to Renewables

As Hawaii continues to push for 100 percent renewable electricity by 2045, it is also focusing on energy efficiency, according to a new report by the Hawaii State Energy Office. In addition, and the past five years, the Energy Services Coalition has ranked the state first in government for energy performance contracting.



Montana and Wyoming Governors Release Report on Carbon Capture and Sequestration Technology

Two more states are leading the way in realizing the benefits of carbon capture and sequestration (CCS) technology. Montana Governor Steve Bullock and Wyoming Governor Matt Mead recently released a report on CCS and possible state policies to encourage its use.



NASEO Releases Report on Incorporating Alternative Fuel Vehicles into Emergency Operations Plans

NASEO's Initiative for Resiliency in Energy through Vehicles (iREV) recently released a report, "Baseline Assessment: Alternative Fuel Vehicles in State and Municipal Emergency Operations Plans," which provides an overview of emergency operations plans, summarizes key findings from a scan of alternative fuel vehicle (AFV) inclusion in state and local plans, and identifies opportunities to include AFVs in future emergency plans.



DOE Releases Electromagnetic Pulse Resilience Action Plan

On January 9, the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Electricity Delivery and Energy Reliability released the department's Electromagnetic Pulse Resilience (EMP) Action Plan as part of an ongoing effort to further understand and manage the risks associated with EMPs.



NY Green Bank Announces the Closing of 13 Transactions in 2016, Spurring Thousands of Clean Energy Projects

NY Green Bank recently announced that it closed 13 transactions during 2016, which will result in financing for thousands of clean energy projects, including solar, fuel cells and energy efficiency. The projects are expected to create new jobs in New York's clean energy economy, while spurring substantial economic development.
