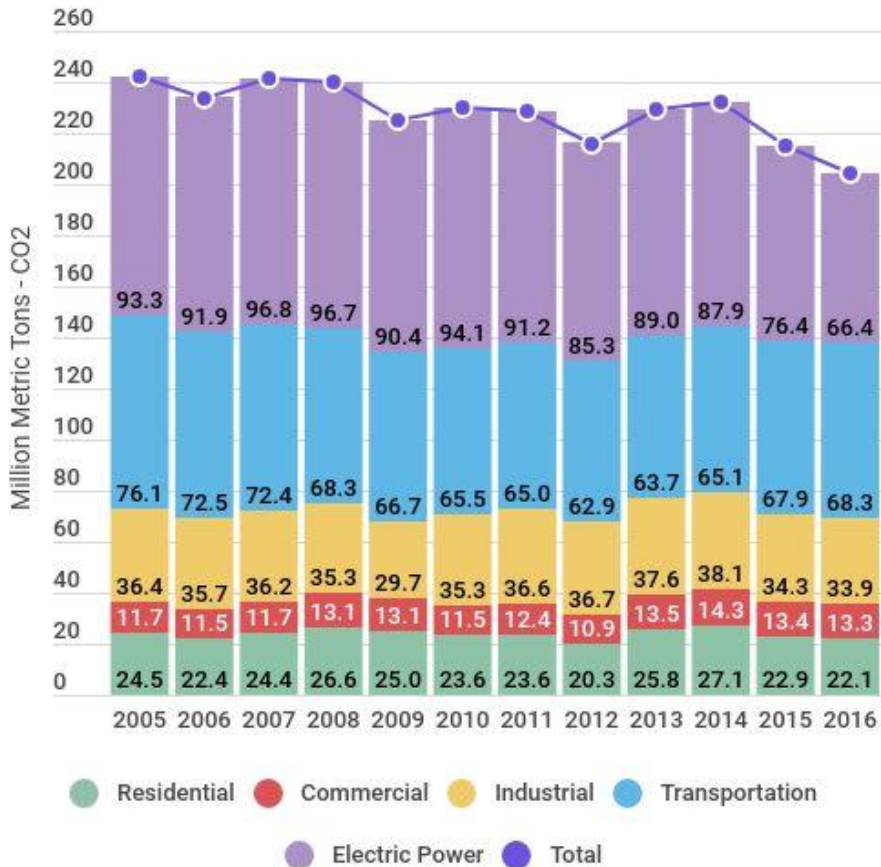


Agency Organization

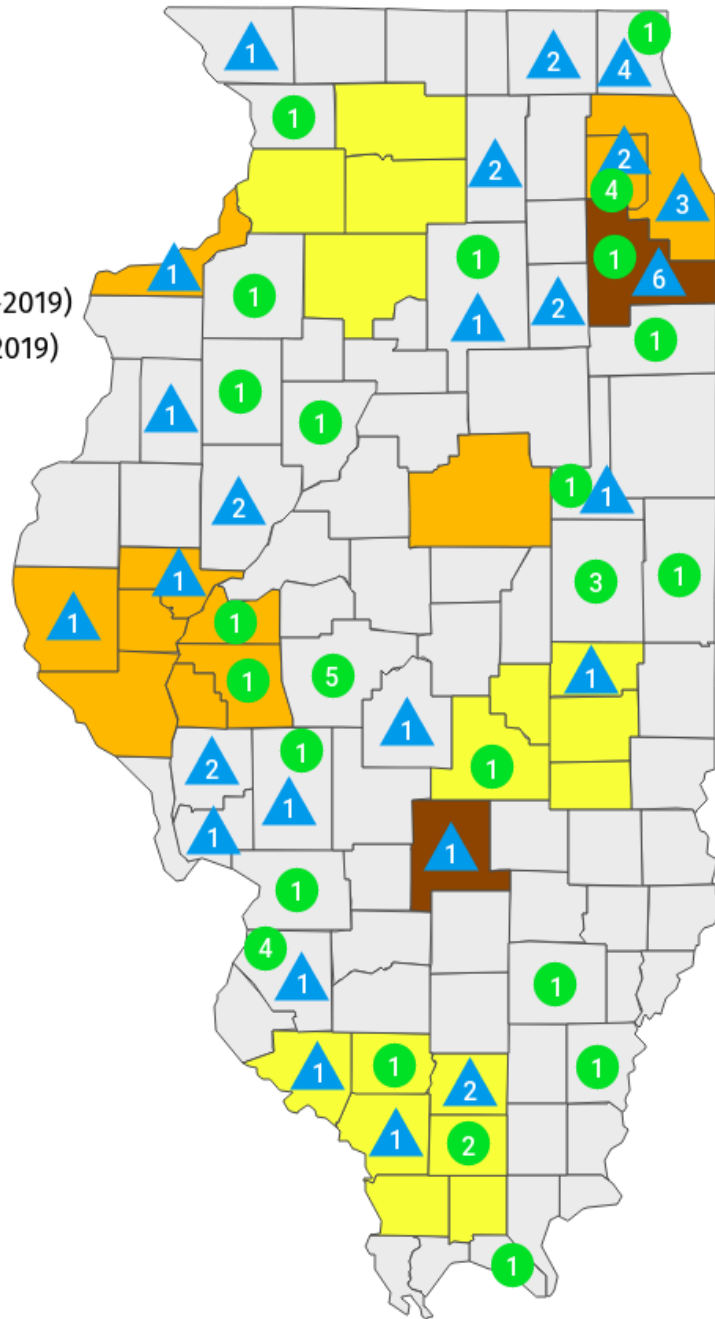

Energy Code Training & Tech Support

Program goal: get all sections of the State on an equal footing

- ▶ Focus is on outreach to rural portions of Illinois
- ▶ Big program shift just by changing the partner: private to public
- ▶ Ten workshops (eight of which were not in Chicagoland) and Five webinars in addition to the continuous online resources
- ▶ Great Feedback and requests for additional programming

WWTP Energy Efficiency

Program Goal: get WWTPs the tools they need to save energy

- ▶ On track to deliver 40 EE Assessment Reports to publicly-owned WWTPs throughout Illinois by June
 - ▶ 20,243,698kWh of Energy Savings!
- ▶ More than 40 additional WWTPs in line to receive reports in the coming year
- ▶ Four Grantees will enjoy:
 - ▶ 6,610,000kWh energy savings
 - ▶ \$408,000 annual savings
