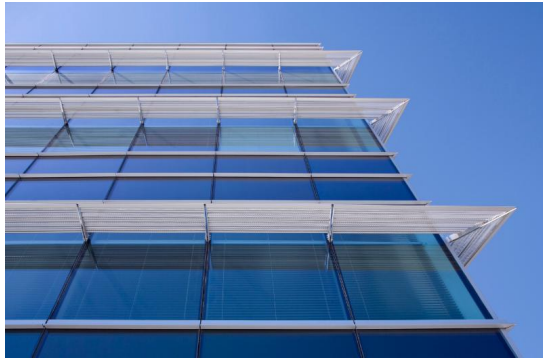
## **New Colorado Governor Signs Historic Executive Order to Promote Electric Vehicles**

The Order cites a recent study which concludes that a "large-scale transition to electric vehicles by 2050 would have cumulative net savings to Coloradans of \$43 billion."
