On June 15, 2020, NASEO filed a protest and additional comments with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) opposing the New England Ratepayers Association's (NERA) effort to eliminate state authority over net metering.

NASEO Releases Cybersecurity Report

On June 5, 2020, NASEO released a new cybersecurity report titled, "Enhancing Energy Sector Cybersecurity: Pathways for State and Territory Energy Offices." The report provides a high-level overview of energy sector cybersecurity roles and responsibilities and identifies specific actions that State Energy Offices can take to enhance internal cybersecurity and support energy sector cybersecurity within their states.

Over the past nine months, NASEO has worked with a variety of organizations to develop a proposed Mission Critical Facility Energy and Resilience Retrofit Program, and would call for \$18 billion of the \$22 billion to run through State Energy Offices via the State Energy Program.



Florida Governor Signs Bill Supporting Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Expansion

On June 9, 2020, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis signed the Essential State Infrastructure Bill into law, which will support the construction of electric vehicle (EV) fast-charging stations along the State Highway System.



Nearly 600,000 Clean Energy Jobs Lost So Far Due to COVID-19, Analysis Reveals

A new analysis by BW Research Partnership for E4TheFuture, Environmental Entrepreneurs, and the American Council on Renewable Energy found a sharp uptick in job losses in the clean energy sector in April 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.



IRS Releases 45Q Tax Credit Proposed Guidance

On May 28, 2020, the U.S. Treasury Department and Internal Revenue Services (IRS) issued proposed regulations on the implementation of the 45Q tax credit, which was signed into law as part of the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018 on February 8, 2018.



FERC to Convene Conferences on Carbon Pricing and Offshore Wind Integration, Invites Comments on Cybersecurity Paper

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) announced it will hold two technical conferences this fall, and is also seeking comments from interested parties on its recently published, "Cybersecurity Incentives Policy White Paper."
